# Rules

1. This tournament is sanctioned by the BTBA the general playing rules will govern with the following special rules:
2. This tournament is open to all members of the BTBA. Failure to produce a current membership card on the day will incur a fine of £1.00.
3. This will be a handicapped tournament throughout with the handicap being based on 70% of the difference between entering average and 220.
4. Entrants must declare their current league/tournament average over 21 games or more. Proof is required.
5. The Tournament managers are Craig Wilson and Sarah Turnbull. Protests must be lodged within 30 minutes and confirmed in writing before the presentation.
6. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute in pinfall cannot be resolved immediately.
7. Registration will open 30 minutes prior to squad time. Latecomers will commence at the frame in progress.
8. Consumption of alcohol is NOT permitted at any time during the tournament. Any infringement will result in immediate disqualification.
9. Inappropriate behaviour (profane language, improper gestures, abuse of bowling equipment/machinery) may result in disqualification.
10. Dress trousers/skirts/skorts must be worn as well as an appropriate t-shirt. Football tops cannot be worn.
11. We have had tournament shirts specially designed to raise money for charity. These details will be sent out when they are available to order.
12. Mobile phones are not permitted during play.
13. Only competitors and tournament officials are allowed on the lanes during play.
14. Closing date for entries is **Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> June**
15. The full entry fee must accompany the entry form and must be received by a tournament manager or can be handed in at Strikeline Pro Shop (AMF Washington). Entry forms will not be accepted and places guaranteed until full payment is received. Only a tournament manager can confirm your place in the tournament. Cheques cannot be accepted.
16. House rules accompany the above; please note consumption of food and drink not bought on premises is NOT permitted at any time within the centre and management reserve the right to confiscate any food/drink not purchased in the centre.

# Tournament Format

**Round 1:** The first round will be split into two squads with all bowlers bowling 5 games at doubles pace. All games will include handicap.

**Round 2:** The top 22 handicap bowlers from round 1 will qualify along with the top 2 scratch bowlers who qualify in the top 22 (seeded 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>). The top 8 bowlers receive a bye to round 3. 16 bowlers will play a **one** game matchplay **inclusive** of handicap. 9<sup>th</sup> will play 24<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> plays 23<sup>rd</sup> and so on.

**Round 3:** The 8 winners from round 2 will play the top 8 bowlers from round 1 in a **one** game eliminator. All games will include handicap.

**Qtr Final:** The 8 winners from round 3 will play a further **one** game eliminator to decide semi-finals. All games will include handicap

**Semi Final:** The 4 winners from the quarter-finals will then play a further **two** game eliminator to decide the final. All games will include handicap.

**Final:** The 2 winners of the semi-finals will contest the final in a final **two** game eliminator. All games will include handicap
