BTBA Sanction Number 17/0062

This is a BTBA sanctioned tournament and the general playing and tournament rules of the BTBA shall govern this event, together with the following special rules.

This tournament is only open to members of the Yorkshire Area of the BTBA

Tournament Managers

The Tournament Managers are Lee Metcalfe and Steven Kay

Tournament Coordinators are Rob Harding and Nathan Glave.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to reject any entry and to decide upon any point not covered in these rules. The Tournament Managers decision shall be final, subject to an appeal to the BTBA. Protests must be lodged with the Tournament Managers within 30 minutes of any infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 60 minutes of the end of the game in question. The Tournament Managers reserve the right to re-rate any entry.

Eligibility

All bowlers must be current BTBA Members through the Yorkshire Area Association and be in good standing

Registration

All Bowlers must register between 9:00 and 9:15 and produce a valid BTBA membership card. Any Bowler unable to produce a current BTBA membership card may participate upon payment of a registration fee of £25.00. This fee will be refunded to the bowler if a current BTBA membership card is shown to a member of the YTBA Committee within 24 hours of play.

Once all bowlers are registered, bowlers will draw their lanes and meet there pot luck Trios team.

Stan Muscroft Plate & Freda Riley Trophy

The highest placed male and female senior after 8 games will be awarded the Stan Muscroft Plate and the Freda Riley Trophy

Scott Banks & Sam Hargreaves Trophies

The Highest placed male and female adult after 8 games will be awarded the Scott Banks and Sam Hargreaves Trophies

Averages & Handicap System

Competitors must declare their current highest average, over 21 games or more at the time of entry, or composite tournament average of 12 games or more, whichever is the highest.

Bowlers with less than 21 games may submit their highest completed average from 1st September 2016.

Entrants who are unable to meet the above requirements will enter on 220 scratch.

Handicaps will be based on 80% of the difference between the entering average and 220.

Verification of averages will be required prior to the start of the tournament.

Bowlers Dress Code

Participants must wear clothing acceptable for public appearance that do not cause offence. Dress code prohibits the wearing of jeans of any colour, denim shirts, singlet vests and shorts unless tailored.

Tournament Rules

A provisional ball shall be rolled in the case of a dispute relating to pin fall which cannot be resolved on the spot. In the event of a tie in any division the highest scratch score from the final game will decide the winner. In the event that this is a tie it will be the highest scratch score from the penultimate game and so on. Only tournament officials, competitors and one licensed instructor/coach will be allowed in the players area during bowling. For details of coaching /instructing see BTBA rule 330. Coaches and instructors are required to display their licence at all times and be dressed in accordance to their position.
