Eligibility

This Tournament is open to teams of 3 bowlers. Each player must have a highest bowling average of less than 150. In the event of a YBC being unable to form a team of 3 from their own YBC, they may with the agreement of the tournament manager use one or two substitutes from other YBCs. Please refer to Tournament Manager in such instances. Teams can be all boys, all girls or mixed.

The Rules and Conditions of the Tournament

- 1. This tournament is sanctioned by the BTBA and the general playing rules of the British Ten Pin Bowling Association will govern this tournament together with the following Special Rules and Conditions.
- 2. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to accept, re-rate or reject any entry and their decision on all matters will be final, subject to the right of appeal to the BTBA.
- 3. Protests of any nature must be lodged by the YBC registered Official with the Tournament Manager within 30 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing before the presentation. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately. No protests will accepted once the presentation has commenced.
- 4. No competitor will be allowed to smoke or consume alcoholic beverages anywhere in the centre during the tournament. Any breach of this rule will result in immediate disqualification of the individual from the tournament. bad language, gesticulation or abuse of bowling equipment or machinery will also result in disqualification. The use of mobile phones by players, officials and coaches is prohibited during play. Any mobile phone taken into the player's area must be switched off. Any individual whose conduct is considered liable to bring the sport into disrepute will be disqualified from the tournament and will be reported to the BTBA for consideration of disciplinary proceedings. Any disqualification may result in the loss of scores and awards.
- 5. Competitors, who in the opinion of the Tournament Manager, are not dressed in the correct bowling attire in the playing area will not be permitted to bowl. Shirts must be of the players YBC and be in the same colour and be of a similar style. Casual shorts, combat style trousers, denim clothing and head gear will not be permitted.
- 6. Only competitors and one licensed representative per team will be allowed in the playing area during play at any one time. The licensed representative must register with the Tournament Manager, display their licence and comply with the dress code.
- 7. Registration for each squad will be 30 minutes prior to bowling, YBC Official only to register all bowlers.
- 8. Bowlers who are late will be allowed to commence bowling at the frame in progress.
- 9. Bowlers must wear YBC bowling attire at the presentation.

10. Tournament Format

a., Three person team event.

Qualifying:

Each team will bowl 4 games in 2 blocks of 2 games over two different pairs of lanes.

Quarter Finals, Semi Finals and Final

The top eight teams over 4 games including handicap will play a further single team game (1^{st} v 8^{th} & 2^{nd} v 7^{th} etc) and the four winning teams will go forward to a single game semi final. The two winning teams will go forward to the final.. The highest scoring team will be declared the winners. The two losing semi-final teams will play off for 3^{rd} & 4^{th} places. Scores from previous rounds will not be carried forward.

We reserve the right to reduce the number of finalists to 4 and squads to 1 should we not receive enough entries.

- b. Players must declare their highest current or completed league or tournament average over a minimum of 21 games since 1st September 2016. The handicap system will be based on 80% of the difference between the bowlers highest league average or tournament average and 150.
- c. Prizes will be awarded to the highest single scratch and handicap games for both Boys and Girls, and for the "best 3 from 4 games" series scratch and handicap games for both Boys and Girls. Prizes will also be awarded to the top 4 teams.
- d. Prizes will take the form of Pro Shop vouchers for the Power Play Pro Shop at Shipley which will be open on the day.
