# Tournament Rules

**This tournament is sanctioned by the BTBA 21/009, and the general playing/ tournament rules will govern this event, along with the following:**

- 1- The tournament is open to BTBA & any other national association members who are in good standing. Non-members will be permitted to play upon payment of a fee equivalent to the annual BTBA membership subscription, currently £25.00**
- 2- A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately.**
- 3- Protests must be made within 30 minutes of any infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 72 hours to the tournament manager.**
- 4- The tournament manager shall be Daniel Bonfield, who reserves the right to reject any entry and his decision on all matters is final, subject to appeal.**
- 5- Closing date for entries shall be 25<sup>th</sup> August 2020. Entries may be taken after this date but will be subject to availability.**
- 6- Adults entering average will be the last highest league or tournament average of 12 games. BTBA tour averages from 2019/2020 are still valid and should be used if a bowler has no newer eligible average. If you have NO average at all we use the bowlers average from this tournament, even if its only over 3 games.**
- 7- Free Fall and String averages are both acceptable without differentiation for all handicap average division based tournaments. Stringed centres are subject to the usual BTBA lane certification process.**
- 8- The same pairing (team) can only cash once**
- 9- No lanes changes - all games in each squad will be played over a pair of lanes.**
- 10- No smoking during play - tournament will disqualify any bowlers found to be smoking during the course of the 3 games.**
- 11- Before, during, and after the event there could be photography, filming or video taken of participants and medal winners by anyone attending the event, either as an official, spectator, parent or guardian. If you (as a participant, parent or guardian) object to this, you must make your objections known to the Tournament Manager prior to the event starting and reasonable adjustments will be made**
