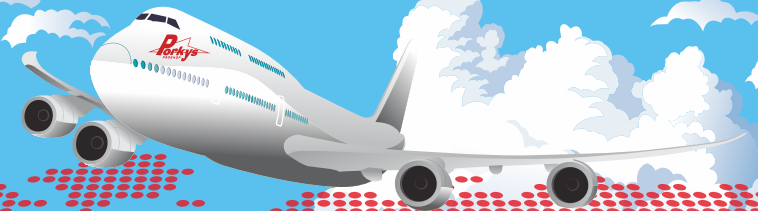

# 2017 LONDON INTERNACIONAL TOURNAMENT RULES

## VENUE

The event will be held at Airport Bowl, Bath Road, Harlington, Middlesex from Thursday 17th August until Sunday 20th August 2017.

## SANCTION

The general playing rules and tournament rules of the British Tenpin Bowling Association will govern the tournament and it will be sanctioned by the BTBA (sanction no 17/0041).

## ELIGIBILITY

This Tournament is open to all members of the BTBA and/or National Association. Non-members and those unable to produce a current Association card may participate upon payment of £2 fine. Non members will not be eligible for BTBA services.

## DEFINITION

The tournament shall be scratch, except that lady entrants, under 18 years of age and aged 50+ on 17th August 2017 shall receive 5 pins per game. Maximum bonus will be 5 pins a game.

## QUALIFICATION

All participants shall bowl 6 games changing lanes after every game. Please see entry form for squadding details. The leading bowler on each day of qualifying is guaranteed a place on Finals Day. Lane dressing will be prior to each qualifying squad. There will be a further opportunity to qualify via a turbo Hi/Lo game, bowlers will be charged £5 per entry and their best Hi/Lo game from the 6 game qualifying block will be chosen (This is your highest and lowest game added together), the highest score will progress.

## RE-ENTRY

The tournament will be re-entry.

## WHO QUALIFIES FOR FINALS DAY?

40 bowlers will qualify in five different ways:

**Group 1** - 8 bowlers with the highest total pinfall over 6 games(including all bonus).

**Group 2** - 24 bowlers with the highest total pinfall over 6 games(including all bonus) but must include any daily winners, not already seeded 1-8.

**Group 3** - 2 bowlers with the best 3 games series [1-3, 4-6] (including all bonus), not included in Groups 1 and 2.

**Group 4** - 2 bowlers with the best single game (including all bonus), not included in groups 1, 2 and 3.

**Group 5** - 4 bowlers from the turbo group with the best Hi/Lo game from the 6 game qualifying block, not included in groups 1, 2, 3 and 4.

In the event of a bowler not being on time for a match, the place will be allocated to the highest non-qualifying 6 game total.

## QUALIFYING PLAYER NUMBERS

Group 1 - Players 1-8 will receive a bye to Final Step 3. It is the responsibility of the finalists to check their squad time and must be available for registration at 09.00 on Sunday 20th August.

## FINALS DAY FORMAT

Finals Step 1 - Groups 2/3/4/5 will play 4 games from scratch. Top 16(50%) bowlers will proceed to Final Step 2.

## Matching in the final steps 2 - 5.

In each of steps 2-5 there will be pools of 4 players. Players will be grouped together based on the consecutive seeding, i.e. Group 1 will be the 4 highest remaining seeds, Group 2 will be the 4 next highest seeds, etc. Each pool (match) will be determined by the highest remaining seed from Group 1 and the lowest remaining seeds from all other groups. In each step a pool will be assigned to a pair of lanes. Two games will be played in each step starting from scratch and the highest two (2) total pinfalls (including any bonuses) will advance to the next step. In Final Step 5, the order of the total pinfalls (including any bonuses) will determine the final four (4) placings

**Finals Step 2** - 16 players from Final Step 1. There will be 4 pools of 4 players. Top 2 from each pool will qualify for Final Step 3.

**Finals Step 3** - 16 players (players positioned 1-8 from qualifying and 8 from Finals Step 2). Top 2 from each pool will qualify for Final Step 4.

**Finals Step 4** - There will be 2 pools of 4 players. Top 2 from each pool will qualify for Final Step 5.

**Finals Step 5** - There will be 1 pool of 4 players. The players will be ranked 1-4 according to their total pinfall.

## TIED GAMES

**Qualifiers:** Ties will be decided by best high game, then if necessary next best, etc. A tie in the turbo will be decided by the highest low game.

**Finals:** 9th/10th frame roll-off. Player on the left lane bowls first ball.

## ENTRY FEE

First entry £75, Re-entry £40, Turbo £5.

First entry fee includes £45.90 prize fund, re-entry £12.90 and Turbo £5, which will be returned in full. Each entry fee includes £1 for Team England Fund.

## ENTRY

Entries should be made half an hour before each squad bowls and be accompanied by the entry fee. Cheques should be made payable to "Airport Bowl".

The Tournament Committee reserve the right to accept or reject entries, and its decision on all matters shall be final, subject to appeal by the BTBA.

Bowlers preferences for squad times and days will be considered where possible, but priority will be given to long distance travellers for the Saturday squads.

## REGISTRATION

All participants MUST register at least 30 minutes before the squad time, and present their BTBA Card or National Association card.

## SCORING

Scores will be kept on official score sheets and must be countersigned by an opponent.

## DRESS CODE

Dress code will be at the discretion of the Tournament Director and Committee. All bowlers will wear a suitable bowling shirt, preferably with their own name or team name. NO DENIM. Jogging bottoms are allowed. Tailored shorts ONLY are permitted. Failure to comply may result in disqualification without refund.

## PROTESTS

A provisional ball must be rolled in the case of a dispute. All protests must be made within one hour and confirmed in writing within 24 hours.

Prizes may be adjusted for increase/decrease in number of entries/re-entries. Figures based on 2016 entries (110).

## PLAYING SPEED

Bowlers will be expected to bowl as soon as the approaches to his/her immediate right and left are clear. Excessive slow play may result in disqualification after a verbal warning.

## NOISE AND THE BOWLER

Entrants should be aware that cheering and applause will be encouraged at all stages of the Tournament. Bowlers must not wait for silence before bowling.
