Sanctioning

This tournament will be sanctioned by the BTBA and the general playing and tournament rules together with the following special rules.

Membership

The tournament is open to current members of the BTBA. Non-members and those unable to produce their current BTBA membership card may participate on payment of a £2.00 waiver. Junior membership would need to be upgraded to full adult membership. This fee is non-returnable.

Dress Code

Dress code prohibits the wearing of denim jeans, denim skirts or singlet vests.

Entrants & Handicaps

Entrants must declare their highest average in any league, tournament or merit table over 21 games on the day of registration.

Any bowler that has participated in a London County sanctioned tournament in the previous 12 months to this tournament will have their tournament average applied; If a bowler has a Lewisham league average this will take preference over any other league average, otherwise the highest entering average will be used. Documentary evidence must be provided in the event of any dispute. If averages are not proven, then the bowler will be rated scratch.

Handicaps will be based on 75% of the difference between the bowler's average and 200, with a maximum of 75 per game. Junior bowlers are not limited to a maximum handicap.

The tournament manager reserves the right to re-rate any bowler as they require.

Format

Competitors will bowl 3 games without changing lanes. The winning team will be the team with the highest total pinfall including handicap at the end of the tournament. In the event of a tie the highest handicap game will determine the winner.

There will be no split for male, female or junior bowlers in the handicap section of this tournament. This is a mixed handicap doubles event.

Re-entry of the same team is allowed, however they will only compete once.

Disputes

A provisional ball will be rolled if a dispute relating to pin fall or fall cannot be resolved immediately. Protests must be made verbally within 30 minutes of occurrence and confirmed in writing within 24 hours. The tournament manager will be Matt Smith and his decision will be final, subject to an appeal to the BTBA.
