Tournament Rules and Regulations:

1. The tournament is sanctioned by the BTBA (sanction no: TBC) and the general playing tournament rules will apply together with the tournament format rules.
2. Players must be current members of the BTBA. Players without proof of membership must pay a £5 fine. Non members will NOT be eligible for BTBA services.
3. The tournament manager will be Kylie Skinner and her decision on all matters shall be final, subject to an appeal to the BTBA.
4. A provisional ball shall be rolled in the event of dispute which cannot be resolved. All protests must be lodged verbally with the tournament manager at the time of the infraction occurring and subsequently confirmed in writing within 72 hours.
5. The wearing of denim jeans, T-shirts, vests and shorts is NOT allowed. Smoking and the consumption of alcoholic beverages is forbidden during play and lane change time.
6. The tournament will be scratch with age bonus pins of one pin per year over the age of fifty, with up to a maximum of 15 pins. (Ladies shall receive an additional 8 pins per game throughout the tournament).
7. BTBA Tour Masters points in both Men's and Ladies sections will be awarded on scratch scores in the 6 games of the qualifying round.

Tournament Format:

1. There will be one qualifying round and depending on total entries, bowlers may be required to play at up to trio's pace.
2. Bowlers will change lanes after every two games and will move 6 lanes—left lanes moving left and right lanes moving right.

Lane Redress:

3. The top 1/3 bowlers after the qualifying round will progress to Round One. Qualifying scores WILL NOT be carried forward.
4. Round One qualifiers will then bowl a further 4 games with total pinfall including bonuses to count moving one pair of lanes after every game.
5. At the end of Round One, the top 8 (from Pinfall & Bonuses), will progress to Round Two.
6. Round Two will consist of the remaining 8 bowlers playing 3 games and will move one pair of lanes to the right after every game.

7. The top 4 from Round Two will progress to the Final.
8. The final will be decided by a Last bowler standing knockout—The four finalists playing one game (including any bonuses), low bowler drops.
9. If a tie occurs, then scratch score will count then if required, a two frame roll off will take place.
10. The remaining three players will play a further one game (including any bonuses) with the low bowler out. If any ties occur, then the same format as above will occur.
11. The last two will bowl a one game decider, again with the same format as above.
12. The winner will be the last bowler left on the lanes.
