TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is sanctioned by the BTBA and will be played under their General Playing and Tournament rules, together with the following special rules.
2. Bowlers who are not members of the BTBA or fail to provide proof of membership are permitted to bowl providing they sign up for a year's BTBA membership (£21.00). If the membership is subsequently proved 14 days after the conclusion of the tournament the individuals £21.00 will be returned.
3. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pin fall cannot be resolved immediately.
4. Protests must be made within 30 minutes of any infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 72 hours to the Tournament Manager.
5. The Tournament Manager is LISA JOHN. She reserves the right to reject any entry and her decision on all matters shall be final, subject to an appeal to the BTBA.
6. Closing date for entries will be 10pm on Sunday 15th July 2018 and all entry fees must be paid in cash on the day. Squads may be reserved by email to the tournament manager, but the entry form **MUST** be received before the closing date. Please note that Squad A is limited to 10 teams, and Squad B to 16.
7. Handicaps shall be based on 100% of the difference between the bowlers entering average and 220. Bowlers must declare their highest League or Tournament average over 12 games as at the closing date. Where a bowler has no average over 12 games he or she may use their latest completed average, subject to a 5 pin drop. Any player with no known average will enter off scratch. Falsification of averages may result in Team disqualification and forfeiture of all prize monies and entry fees. Proof of entering average must be provided at registration.
8. Format:
Each team will bowl 4 games, followed by a lane redress, and then a further 3 games. Each team will move lanes after completing each game.
9. The overall winning teams will be those with either the highest scratch pinfall or highest handicap pinfall.
10. Each team can only win one cash prize. If your team qualifies for a cash prize in the handicap and scratch section, then you will be awarded whatever the highest cash prize is. EXAMPLE; If you finished 3rd in the scratch section and 2nd in the handicap section, you will win the 2nd placed prize in the handicap section, and every team in the scratch section will be moved up a place.
11. BTBA Tour Ranking Points will be awarded based on the individuals scratch score.
12. In the event of a tie, the team with the highest last game will be awarded the place. If this results in a further tie, the team with the highest penultimate game will be awarded the place
13. The wearing of denim jeans, combat clothing, vests is prohibited.
14. This is a non-smoking event and no alcohol is allowed during the competition.
