TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1 This tournament is sanctioned by the BTBA and the General playing and tournament rules will govern this event, together with the following special rules.
- 2 The tournament is open to current members of the BTBA.
Proof of membership will be checked against the BTBA Members List prior to participation.
Non-members may enter, on payment of a £2 surcharge, but will not be eligible for BTBA Services.
- 3 **Closing date for entries is Sunday 11th Nov, Entry Fees may be paid in advance or cash on the day.**
Squads may be reserved by emailing the relevant details to the Tournament Manager, but the entries MUST be received before the closing date.
- 4 **Handicap will be based on 90% of 220 and will be based on a recreational league average of at least 12 games or your average from previous BTBA Tour events in 2018. Proof of entering average must be provided at registration. The maximum handicap for an individual bowler will be 75.**
- 5 The Tournament Manager reserves the right to reject any entry and re-assess any entered average & to disqualify any individual who deliberately submits a false average, subject to an appeal to the BTBA.
- 6 The tournament format is to play 4 games of Handicapped Doubles.
Only the best three (team) games will be counted.
- 7 In the event of a tie, the higher placing will be given to the pairing with the higher final game.
If both teams are still tied at this point then the prize will be split between them.
- 8 A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately.
- 9 Protests must be made within 30 minutes of any infraction occurring and confirmed in writing within 72 hours to the Tournament Manager.
- 10 Re-entry is permitted, although such a pairing may only claim one prize.
It is possible for a bowler to make more than one entry with a different partner.
Both of these pairs would be eligible for prizes.
- 11 The wearing of denim jeans, combat style clothing or vests is not permitted.
- 12 This is a non-smoking event and no alcohol is allowed during the competition.
- 13 **The Entry Fee will be £16 per bowler (£32 per team).**

Statement from the BTBA on the subject of String Pins and Averages:

STRING MACHINE v FREE FALL AVERAGES

Following a decision by the BTBA Executive, Free Fall and String averages will both be accepted without differentiation for all handicap tournaments as from 1st August 2018. BTBA members will therefore have the opportunity of competing in tournaments on both String and Free Fall. Over 20% of all lanes in the UK are set to become String by the end of 2019. They will be subject to the usual lane certification process.
