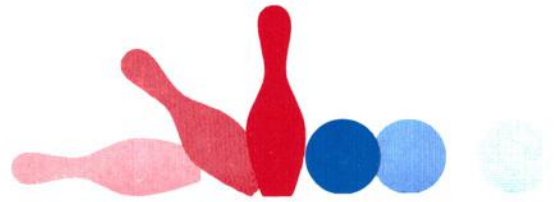

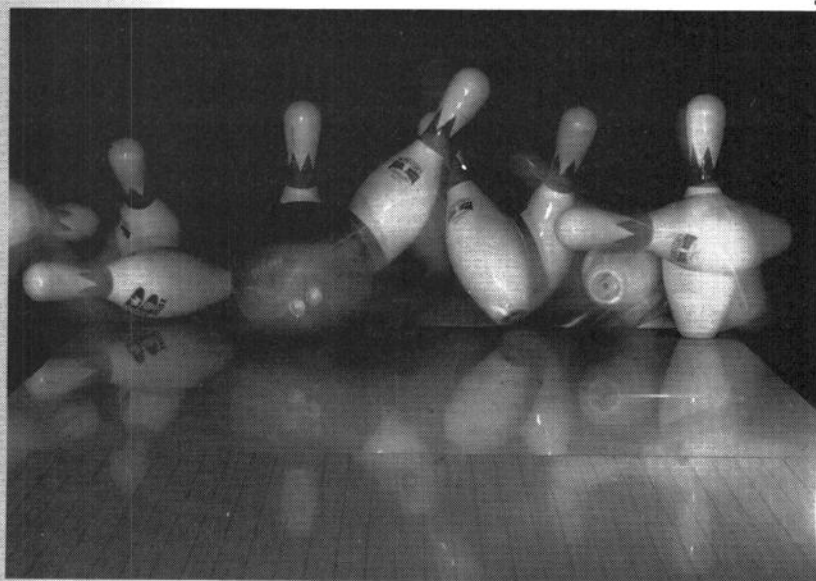
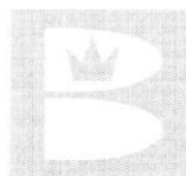

The Commonwealth Games has always been known as the 'Friendly Games' (remember the closing ceremony fun and frolics) and, for the first time ever they have a friendly major sponsor to go with the title.

CG athletes, from a range of participating sports will be visiting 125 schools nation-wide offering coaching of the highest standard to youngsters just starting out on their sporting careers. England will be sending over 350 athletes to Kuala Lumpur, competing in 13 of the 15 sports. Tenpin Bowling, like many other team sports, has been included in the Commonwealth Games for the first time, and is one of the 15 sports that will be swelling the number of athletes in Malaysia to over 6,000 from 60 different countries.
